**Revised Local Hotel Accommodation Rates**

### Introduction 1.0

Please be advised that the revised local hotel accommodation rates are attached to this Circular as Annex I and will take effect from 27 October 2025.

### **Eligibility and Conditions** 2.0

Hotel accommodation may be provided to civil servants who are required to stay overnight for official duties outside their normal workstations, in accordance with the approved ceiling rates.

The ceiling rate is defined as the maximum allowable rate per night that a Ministry may pay for an employee's accommodation at a local hotel.

#### 3.0 **Eligibility Categories**

Civil servants eligible for hotel accommodation are categorized as follows:

Category I: Permanent Secretaries and Officers on Band M and above.

Category II: All other Officers on Band L and below.

#### 4.0 **Quotation Requirements**

Ministries must obtain and submit three official quotes for hotel accommodation, selecting the most cost-effective or practical option within the approved ceiling rates.

## Subsistence Allowance for Unavailability of Accommodation

In cases where hotel accommodation is not available, Clause 503(a) of the 2011 General Orders will apply, with subsistence allowance capped at \$30.00 per night.
